Job Summary:

Responsible to the Executive Director and supervised by the Administrative Assistant, The Family Violence Counsellor is responsible for planning, implementing and evaluating programs designed to provide holistic services for individuals experiencing family violence, domestic abuse and gender-based violence. The counsellor will provide individual and group counselling to residential and non-residential clients, maintain a current and broad network of community-based and public sector services and stays current with best and emerging practices in the field. The counsellor provides immediate crisis stabilization services, as well as longer term support to assist clients to achieve stable housing, economic stability, positive community connections and healthy relationships.

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate degree in Human Services such as a Bachelor of Social Work degree, Applied Counselling Certificate and/or an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
